Intensive Care Unit (ICU) Reno, NV	The 12-bed medical and surgical unit provides care to patients with life-threatening, potentially reversible illnesses, and patients requiring critical post surgical care. Experience preferred. (12 hr. shifts).
Emergency Department Reno, NV	Provides emergency and urgent care medical services for veteran patients. This is not a trauma designated Emergency Department. Experience preferred (12 hr. shifts).
Medical Surgical/Telemetry Reno, NV	Inpatient 38 bed acute unit provides care to surgical, medical, and telemetry patients; primary patient population includes those requiring preoperative/postoperative care, management of acute medical conditions and telemetry. Experience preferred. (8 hour shifts).
Psychiatry Unit, Inpatient Reno, NV	Inpatient 14 bed acute psychiatry unit provides care to patients with general acute psychiatric illness. Inpatient psych experience preferred. (12 hour shifts).
Mental Health, Outpatient Reno, NV	Provides psychiatric and addiction services in mental health clinic; outpatient mental health experience preferred. (Mon-Fri)
Perioperative Services: Reno, NV OR ___ PATPU ___ Cath lab ___ PACU ___ Endoscopy ___	Includes operating room, recovery room, endoscopy, cath lab, pre-admission testing/ processing, interventional radiology nursing care. Broad array of surgical and interventional procedures provided to inpatients and outpatients. Current experience in area of interest is preferred.
Float Reno, NV	Full or part time positions; covers staffing needs in ICU, Emergency Department, Medical/Surgical Unit, and CLC. Experience preferred. (8 and 10 hour shifts)
Community Living Center (CLC) Reno, NV	Inpatient 60 bed unit providing sub acute and acute care to patients with multiple medical problems such as impaired mobility, incontinence, mental status changes, dementia, post chemotherapy/radiation therapy, and terminal illnesses. Includes short and long term restorative, rehabilitative, and hospice patients. Experience preferred. (8 hour shifts).
Home Based Primary Care (HBPC)	Provides primary care to veteran patients in their home environment. Areas of coverage include 35 miles or 30 minutes from the Medical Center or the assigned Community Based Outpatient Clinic (CBOC).
VA Sierra Foothills CBOC Auburn, California	Outpatient clinic only (100 miles west of Reno campus) offers primary care and mental health services. Mon -Fri. Experience preferred.
VA Lahontan Valley CBOC Fallon, Nevada	Outpatient clinic only (60 miles east of Reno campus) offers primary care and mental health services. Mon- Fri. Experience preferred.
VA Diamond View CBOC Susanville, California	Outpatient clinic only (60 miles north of Reno campus) offers primary care and mental health services. Mon-Fri. Experience preferred (Projected opening late spring/summer 2010)
VA Carson Valley CBOC Minden, Nevada	Outpatient clinic only (45 miles south of Reno campus) offers primary care and mental health services. Mon-Fri. Experience preferred
Primary Care Reno, NV	Provides comprehensive, coordinated and continuous health care services for veteran patients in an outpatient clinic setting; also urgent care and mental health services. Mon-Fri. Experience preferred.
Specialty Clinics Reno, NV	Consultant clinics offer care in both medical and surgical specialties in an outpatient setting; also chemotherapy/infusion center and special procedure areas (i.e. thoracentesis, paracentesis, minor surgical procedures limited to local anesthesia only). Mon-Fri. Experience preferred.
Telephone Care Reno, NV	Systematically assesses and addresses patient needs to determine emergent care, urgent care, routine follow-up, or self care treatments by following established guidelines. Also included is Care Coordination, which uses home telephone messaging/monitoring devices and video telephone technology to provide disease management and health maintenance. Mon-Fri Experience preferred.
Nurse Practitioner	Provides care in various clinical settings which could include primary care, specialty clinics, medicine service, surgical services, or CLC; may also perform preoperative H&Ps, or physical examinations to document health status information; may facilitate/coordinate needed care in other settings.
Quality Management Reno, NV	Includes accreditation, surveys, utilization review, case management, risk management, discharge planning, patient safety, infection control, MRSA, performance measures/monitors, quality chart review, peer review, patient flow, surgical improvement project. Experience preferred.
Business Service – Fee Basis, Utilization Review Reno, NV	Involved in the documentation, assessment, review, coordination, and data collection of activity related to non VA patient services, including fee basis consults, transfers, clinical follow up, resource management, and level of care determination. Experience preferred.
